3rd August 2011 Future Streatham Update

Works to begin this month on Streatham Hub

The final important documents have now been signed off by Lambeth Council and Tesco which will allow works to begin on the multi-million pound Streatham Hub development.

The development agreement that is now signed will help regenerate the area around Streatham station and provide up to 600 much needed jobs, 250 new homes (89 of which will be for affordable housing), a new leisure centre, including an ice rink, and a Tesco store. Continuity of ice facilities in Lambeth will be maintained by a temporary ice rink, which will be located in Brixton throughout the duration of works.

Ice hockey matches and ice dance practice will all be possible, alongside public skating, at the temporary rink which will operate from a site on Pope's Road, Brixton for two and a half years and will then be fully decommissioned.

Preparation works ahead of construction on the temporary ice rink site are due to begin this week. The temporary ice rink is due to open in the New Year.

Preparation works ahead of construction on the main Streatham Hub site will begin later in August and are due to be completed towards the end of 2013.
